The Meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. Members in attendance were Mayor Jerry Weber, Dot Sharp, Cory Cucchiara, Kyle White, Scott Miller and Sam Keller. Clerk Jenni Straughan, Brian Keller and Steve Bremer were also in attendance.

**Minutes:** Sam Keller motioned to accept the minutes and Dot Sharp seconded the motion. The vote was carried by voice and passed by all.

**New Business:****Public Hearing on 2019 Budget:**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m. Members in attendance were Mayor Jerry Weber, Dot Sharp, Cory Cucchiara, Kyle White, Scott Miller and Sam Keller. Clerk Jenni Straughan, Brian Keller and Steve Bremer were also in attendance.

Jenni reviewed the 2019 Budget, Ordinance #502. She explained that the county left the town's levy off the November ballots and that she had to remove the \$30,000 from the 2019 budget. After some discussion, the public hearing was closed with a motion by Dot Sharp and second by Cory Cucchiara. The vote was carried by voice and passed by all. Meeting closed at 7:43 p.m.

**Discharging:**

Steve told the council that discharging has been stopped due to high PH tests. He explained that he is working on getting a cable/pulley system in place so that he can take samples deeper in the reservoir.

**Special Levy:**

Whitman County left the town's levy off the November ballot. The town's levy will be on the February 2019 Ballot. It was decided that the special levy in February will be strictly for painting the inside of the water tank. Jenni will get a newsletter out letting the town residents know about the special levy.

**Ordinance #502, 2019 Budget:**

Sam Keller motioned to accept the 2019 Budget and Scott Miller seconded the motion. The vote was carried by voice and passed by all.

**Old Business:****Brian Keller:**

Marshal Keller told the council that the police car has had everything installed except for the radio, which should be here in the next couple of weeks. Marshal Keller will order the decals so that it is marked.

**Steve Bremer:**

Steve told the council that the culvert at Howard’s property has been cleaned out. He said that the bill is going to be around \$2,500 because the company has to pay prevailing wage.

A motion to close the meeting was made by Dot Sharp and seconded by Sam Keller. The motion was carried by voice and passed by all. The meeting adjourned at 8:06 p.m.
