CHAPTER 5.04

LICENSING OF PEDDLERS OF GOODS, WARES AND MERCHANDISE

- <u>5.04.010 Definitions</u>. The term "peddler" for the purpose of this Chapter shall be construed to include all persons, both principals and agents, who go from place to place and house to house carrying for sale and offering for sale or exposing for sale goods, wares or merchandise of any kind.
- <u>5.04.020 License Requirement</u>. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any peddler except peddlers of farm products of any kind which they have grown or raised, to sell or offer for sale any goods, wares or merchandise of any kind within the corporate limits of the Town of Colton without having first procured a peddlers license as in this chapter provided.
- $\underline{5.04.030 \text{Licensing Fee}}$. The license fee for peddlers in the Town of Colton shall be \$5.00 per day of twenty-four hours, which shall be paid to the Town Treasurer.
- <u>5.04.040 Issuance of License</u>. Upon presentation of a receipt for the payment of the license the City Clerk shall issue to the applicant a license to peddle goods, wares or merchandise of any kind in the Town of Colton for the time in said license mentioned.
- <u>5.04.050 Penalties</u>. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00 and costs no more than \$150.00 and cost, by the discretion of the Colton Municipal Court.

CHAPTER 5.08

ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS SET BY THE WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD
