The Fire District has a new Fire Chief, Jay Reisenauer. His phone number is 509-597-7531. The council would like to thank Jon Dahmen for his years of service.

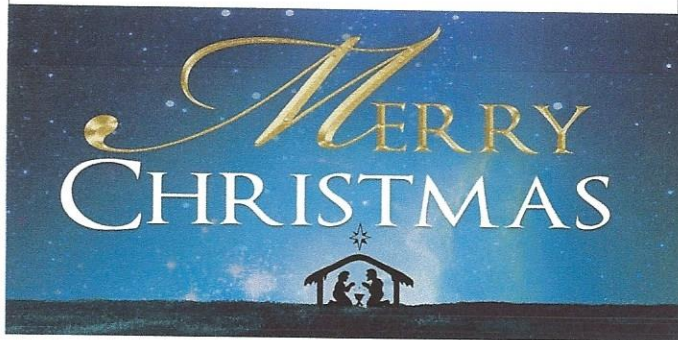
Special Levy

The water and sewer rates will go up 4% in February, which is an increase of \$3.37 a month. The base water rate will now be \$39.89 and the sewer rate will be \$47.91.

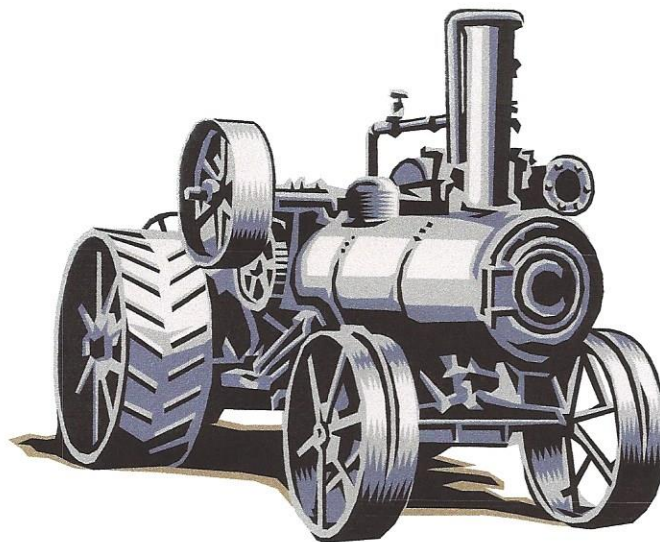
Winter Reminders:
