If you get behind on your utility bill, the town will not disrupt your service and will not send out shut off notices. Just pay what you can. The town will work with you until you can get caught up.

The Public Works Department is open, but the door is locked. Please try to handle business by phone or email whenever possible. The number is 509-229 -3717. If you must conduct business with the Public Works Director, please call to schedule an appointment.

Colton's Whitman County Library is closed to the public. Items may be ordered online and will be sent directly to your home. You may return items via the external drop box. If you have questions, please call 509-229-5278.
