Water and Sewer

Please remember that your water meter readings are only estimated during the winter months. Don't be surprised if your water bill is higher when actual reads are taken in the spring. Also, per resolution, the water rate will go up 4% in February 2022, which is an increase of \$1.66 a month. The base water rate will be \$43.15. The council did approve the \$20.00 rate increase for sewer, passing resolution #810 at the November Council Meeting. This increase is to help pay for the town's upcoming sewer system upgrade.
