The town will be changing recycling services, starting March 1st. Whitman County Recycling is a single stream recycling company. What that means is that everything that is recyclable goes into one bin. Whitman County also accepts plastics, numbered 1-7. All cardboard must be broken down and able to slip through the slots provided. Please do not leave boxes outside of the bin. Please ensure all recyclables are cleaned out. Please refer to Whitman County's Recycling flyer that is attached for all of the details.

Items **NOT ACCEPTED** are garbage, glass, plastic bags, styrofoam, food contaminated items, microwave trays, ceramic, dishes, light bulbs, window glass or mirrors, hazardous waste containers, syringes, un-numbered plastic, lids, batteries, electronics, sharp metal, coated or laminated paper products.


