September 2nd, 2025

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Members in attendance were Mayor Jerry Weber, Dot Sharp, Ken Darby, Scott Miler, Sam Keller, Cory Cucchiara, Jenni Straughan and Steve Bremer.

Minutes: Sam Keller motioned to approve the minutes and Dot Sharp seconded the motion. The vote was carried by voice and passed by all.

Treasurer's Report:

New Business:**Steve:****Street Sweeper:**

Steve told the council that the street sweeper finally came and removed the rock from the TIB project.

Town's Light Poles:

The town's light poles need to be replaced. Steve will try to get a hold of a contractor to order some.

Ongoing Business:**A T&T Park:**

Jenni told the council that AT&T had called her and said that they are interested in selling the lot to the town. She is waiting to hear back from them.

Speed Trailer for Steptoe:

The speed trailer has been placed on Steptoe by GASB. Mayor Weber switched it to track cars going into town and it seems to be working well.

Curtis Concrete:

Steve told the council that the town received a bill from Curtis Concrete and that the square footage was incorrect. Steve contacted Curtis about this and he hasn't heard back yet.

TIB RRFB's:

Steve told the council that TIB wanted to know why the town wasn't putting in the second RRFB on Gregor Street, since TIB awarded the town for both streets. Steve explained that there was no room for an RRFB on Gregor Street because of the flashing school zone sign and the telephone pole. Keller and WSDOT are going to discuss if it is still possible to put one in there. Steve will call for locates. If it is not possible one on Gregor Street, then the town will have to fill out paperwork explaining why it is not being placed there and TIB will reassess the grant award.

Back Hoe:

Jenni told the council that she heard back from Uniontown that they are not interested in changing anything. They want to keep the agreement the same.

Sewer Project Update:

The lowest bid for the wastewater project came back 2 million more than Keller Associates had anticipated. Keller has been in touch with DOE to find out if they will cover the additional costs.

A motion to close the meeting was made by Sam Keller and seconded by Cory Cucchiara. The vote was carried by voice and passed by all. The meeting closed at 7:57 p.m.
