New Business:**Jody Moehrle:**

Jody Moehrle addressed the council to express her gratitude for the ongoing support of the school district. She informed the council about the need to renovate the playground, emphasizing that improvements are necessary for both functionality and safety. Specifically, Jody explained that the corner near the playground requires backfilling and building up because the curb is deteriorating and the bank is experiencing erosion. In addition, she noted the intention to add a sidewalk for safety. She presented mapping for the council to review. The council explained that they would like to see if this project could be covered with the TIB grant. Jenni will contact them to find out.

Sewer Project Update:

Steve and Jenni met with Keller Associates regarding potential funding for the additional two million to complete the project. Cemetery Mapping Programs:

Jenni told the council that she is looking into software for cemetery mapping. The town needs a digital system to make it more easily accessible.
